



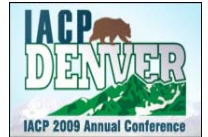

MEET THE TEAM



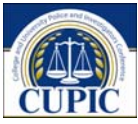

Voyager OnLine Reporting (VOL)

Are you aware that all users can access previously run queries through our secure web portal? Simply go to VOL LINK at <https://www.voyagersystemsinc.com/>, and enter your user name and password. From there you can cycle through all of your previously run queries and messages using our robust search tool. Entries can be retrieved with even partial information, just enter the information in the appropriate fields and click Search. Voyager OnLine can also be used by administrators to run productivity reports. Per FBI CJIS guidelines, all information is kept securely on our Voyager Server indefinitely and is only accessible to your agency. CUPIC WRAP UP – VOYAGER SUPPORTS CAMPUS POLICE



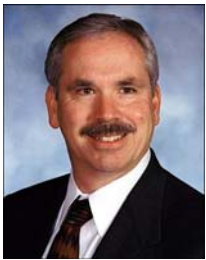
